Parent Survey 2023-2024

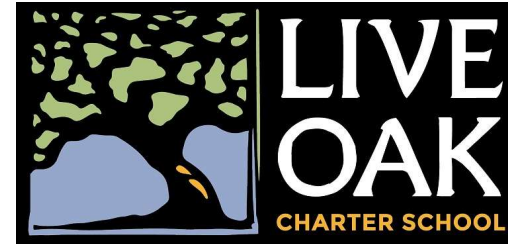


Parent Survey Goals



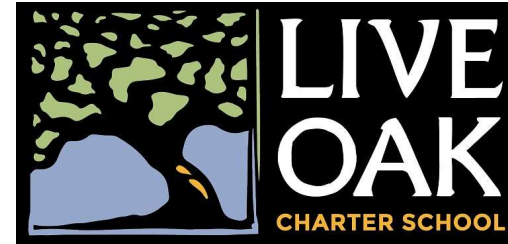
- Gather information that is useful to the board, administration, and other stakeholders.
- Provide a survey experience that is in line with our values as a school.
- Include as many families as possible.
- Include all stake holders in the planning process (board & admin are core team members; staff & foundation have been invited to participate).

Parent Survey History



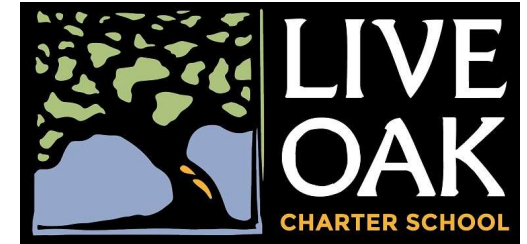
- A survey gathering feedback from families is sent annually late February/early March.
- 51% of our families responded last year, lower than previous years (It was 76% in 22/21 and 65% in 20/21). Last year was the year we migrated communication to ParentSquare.
- Last year, we moved the survey from Survey Monkey to Google Docs. There was an attempt to make the survey less corporate and warmer. We also made the LCAP questions much easier to answer.
- Last year, we learned that almost 90% of our families who have joined over the past few years chose us for our Waldorf curriculum (rather than liking Live Oak more than other options).
- Our surveys generally take 10-20 minutes to complete.

Parent Survey Summary



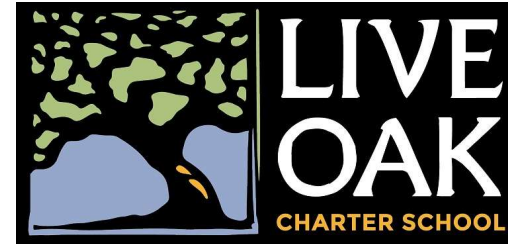
- The parent survey is designed specifically for the caregivers of our students, and is sent out each spring. We provide a summary of the results to the community in late spring. The survey is anonymous.
- There are four main sections of the survey:
 - Feedback for each child, asked annually. If multiple children attend from one family, these questions are asked for each child attending. These questions provide grade specific and staff specific feedback.
 - Topical questions the board and administration uses for planning purposes. Last year, we asked about ParentSquare, our school calendar, and priorities for our budget.
 - LCAP goals feedback
 - General feedback about Live Oak, including likeliness to recommend, what they like best, and opportunities for growth. These are mostly open-ended questions.

What are the Board's Questions?



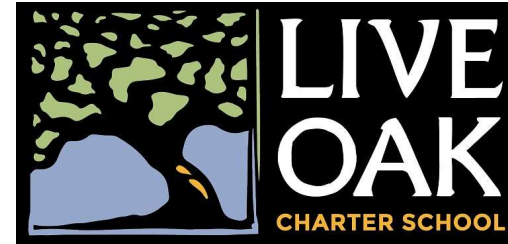
- What would we like to focus on this year? What do we want to know from or about our community?
- Questions should provide responses that are actionable and realistic.
- In our review of last year's survey, our overall takeaway was we wanted questions that are meaningful and highlight our strategic plan around student joy, creating community and belonging, institutional stability, and deepening our Waldorf practices.

Other Possible Changes



- Survey distribution – We’d like more responses, so we need to plan additional notifications to the community in different ways (e.g. signage at school with a QR code, link in other ParentSquare notifications (Linda’s email?), class coordinator email out.
- Survey results – share with class coordinators? Via ParentSquare?
- Other ideas?

Next Steps

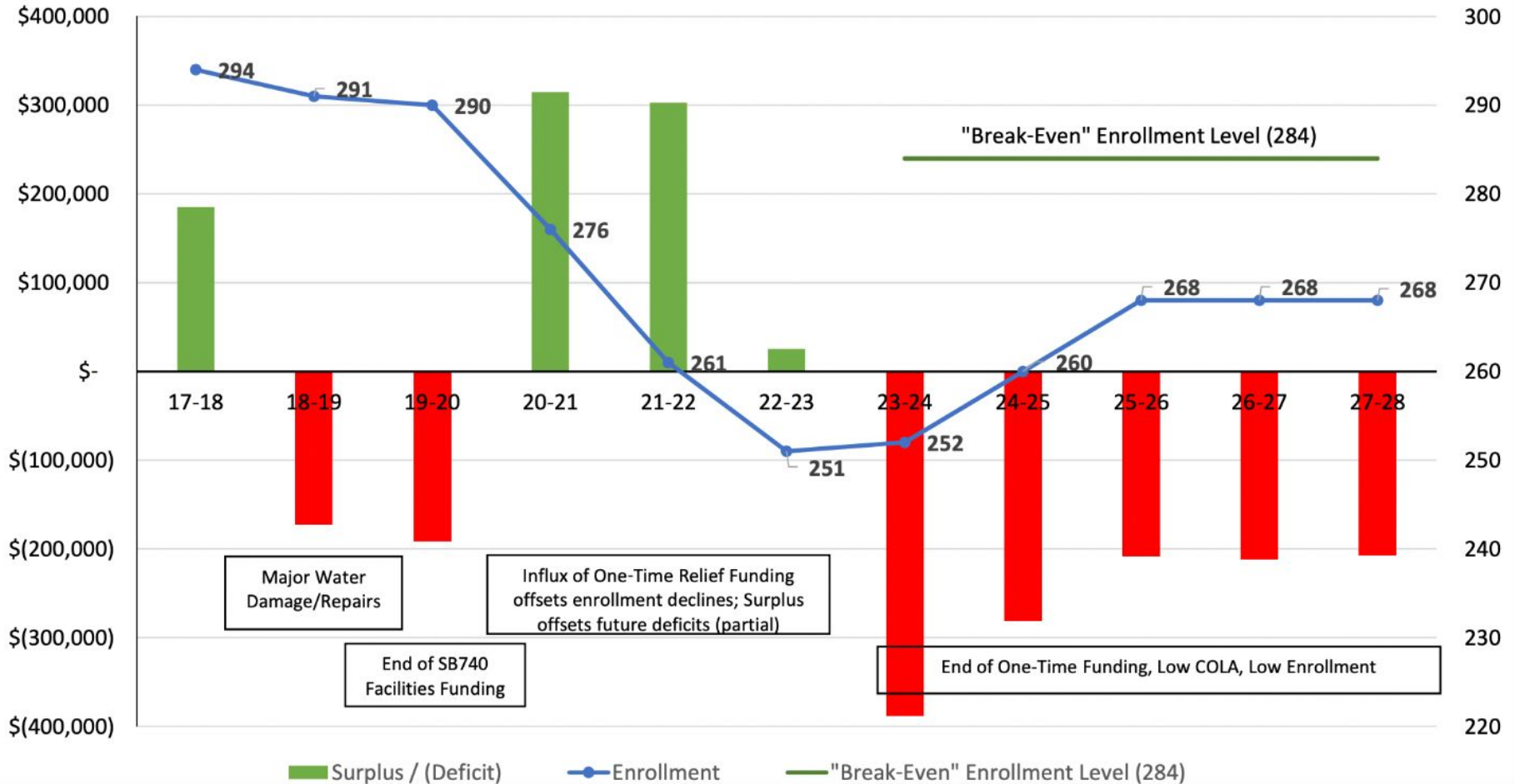


- Create questions for this year, including stakeholders in the process

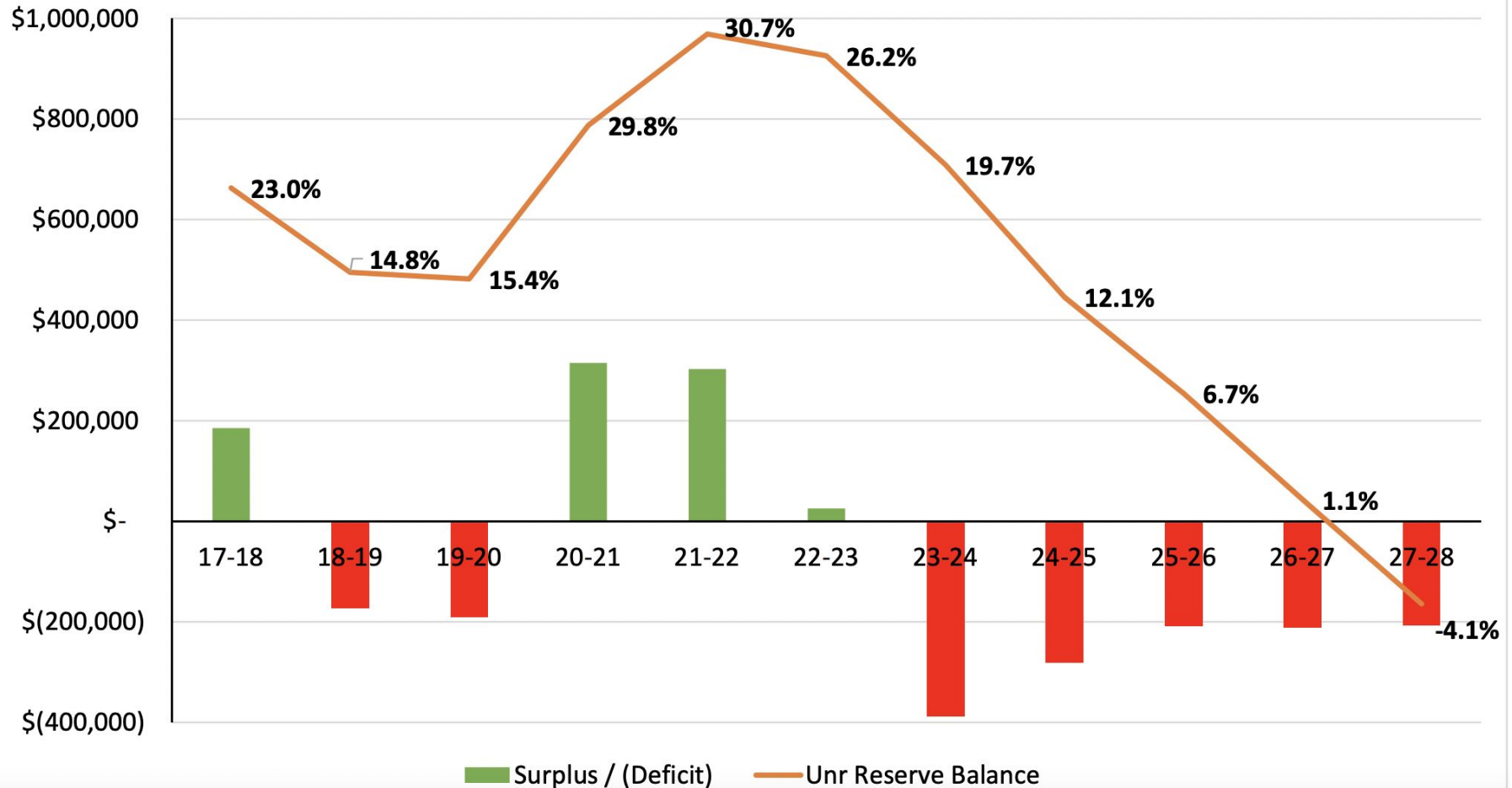

Surplus/(Deficit) and Enrollment [Current Projection]

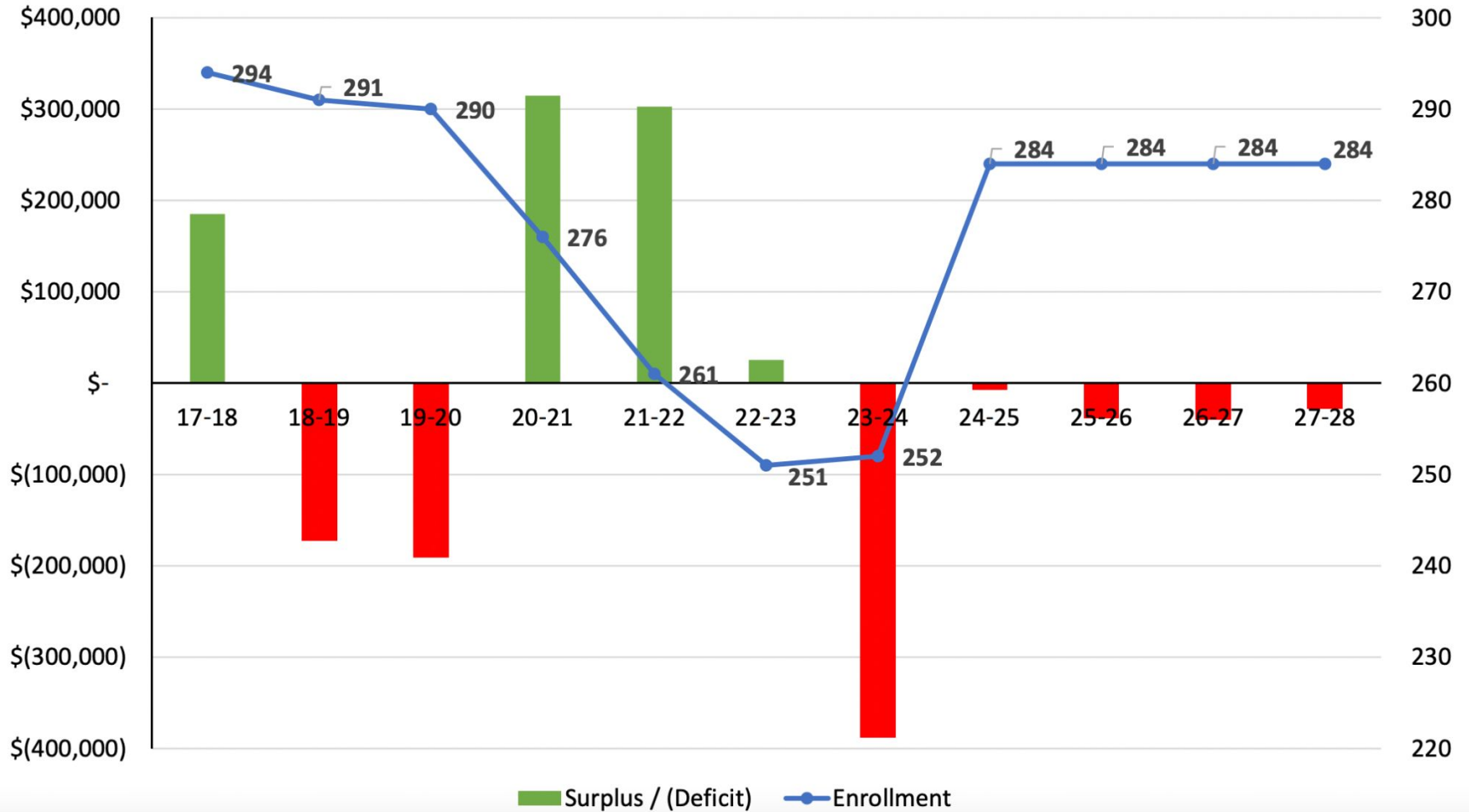
