Dear Live Oak Charter Community,

A Red Flag Warning has been issued by the [National Weather Service](#) for the North Bay Mountains **from Sunday, October 25 at 11:00 AM through Tuesday, October 27, 2020 at 5:00 AM.**

A Red Flag Warning means that critical fire weather conditions are either occurring now or will shortly. A combination of strong winds, low relative humidity, and warm temperatures can **contribute to extreme fire behavior.**

I know Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS) have been issued and/or have begun and may last until Tuesday or possibly later. There is no scheduled PSPS for Live Oak Charter scheduled as of now.

I am anticipating that we will continue distance learning this week. If you live in an area that does experience a PSPS, please know that we will work with you in completing any work and/or with any work that may need to be made up later. Also, any absences due to PSPS will be an excused absence.

In the event that there is a change, more information will be forthcoming.
